

## Hazard Identification Guide

The following identifies hazards that may be present at the worksite

### Work Area

- Repetition strain injuries from inadequate workspace or poorly designed tools & equipment
- Badly sited furniture chairs, tables etc
- Cramped rooms
- Debris on ground
- Exposure to noise
- Fire risk
- Water on ground
- Footing uneven, obstructed, slippery
- Hazards from nearby operations
- Inadequate lighting
- No assessment of the risk of hazard exposure at the worksite

### Machinery

- Poor/inadequate/removed Guarding
- Water on ground
- Those in the area where machinery is used

### Tools

- Using the wrong tool for the job
- Tool placement in and unsafe position when not in use
- Tool in unsafe condition/poorly serviced

# Chemicals

- No Labels especially on smaller containers substances have been decanted into
- Inappropriate Containers for decanting (food and beverage containers)
- Inappropriate Storage
- Poor Handling methods
- No MSDS's and no risk assessments completed for hazardous substances
